## PROSPECTUS

### 1. FOREWORD

Roseview Primary School in Bloemfontein, Free State, RSA is a progressive English medium school and its values are found in the Christian ethos. The child is educated with an all round approach which features Christian principles, academic and social behaviour and physical development. Strict discipline exists in order to create an atmosphere conducive for learning and teaching, which is to the benefit of all concerned.

### 2. HISTORY OF SCHOOL

Our school was founded on 1 January 1994 as the Van Kerken Primary School, the first Model D Primary School in Bloemfontein. The school started with 165 learners from Grade 1 to Grade 3. The staff consisted of a principal and six educators. On 29 July 1994 the name of our school was changed to Roseview Primary School. The school moved from their old premises in Eeufees Road in Bloemspruit to their new premises in Victoria Road in Willows on 11 October 1999. The school has 1056 learners.

### 3. SCHOOL SONG

The school song was written by Mr. P.J. Pretorius and Mr. F.J. Pretorius and composed by Mrs. R. van Zyl and Mrs. E.L. van Rooyen. Officially it was first sung on 29 July 1994.

## 9. SCHOOL UNIFORM

### 9.1 Girls

Summer (Oct. – April)

School dress (Prescribed green and white check dress) short white socks (not towel cloth) and black shoes (lace up or with straps. **No tekkies!!!**)

Winter (May – September)

Bottle green winter long pants, white long sleeve shirt, navy school jersey, navy sleeveless pullover, with badge), school windbreaker (School badge embroidered on) navy tie, white socks, black school shoes. No tekkies and no beanies allowed. No tracksuits will be permitted.

Hair Accessories:

- White, navy, green elastics, ribbons and clips.
- Earrings – only silver and gold studs – no diamonds.
- Thin earrings not bigger than a 10c coin. Thickness same as paperclip.

Short hair. Extensions must be black. Long hair must be fastened. **No coloured hair.**

### 9.2 Boys

Summer (Oct. – April)

Grey school shirt with long or short sleeves, T-shirts may not show under shirt!! Normal accepted grey short/long school pants, grey school socks and black school shoes, lace – up, without buckles. No tekkies!!!!

Winter (May – September)

Grey long sleeve shirt, grey long pants, navy school jersey, navy sleeveless pullover (with badge), school windbreaker (School badge embroidered on) navy tie, grey socks, black school shoes. No tekkies and no beanies allowed. No tracksuits are permitted.

Hair

Short – No extensions - No coloured hair.

The amount due for school fees is determined annually by the School Governing Body. School fees for 2015 is:

R3850 per child per year. This amount can be paid in full, quarterly or R350-00 per month January – November (11 months). If the full amount is paid before the end of April 2015 school fees will be R3.500-00 and before the end of June 2015 – R3.675-00. If paid in full after the end of June 2015 the full amount of R3.850-00 is payable.

#### 12.4 ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

When a child is absent, the parent must notify the educator or principal's office.

#### 12.5 PARENT MEETINGS

Parent meetings are held once a term.

#### 12.6 SCHOOL GOVERNING BODY

The School Governing Body is elected every three years. The function of the SGB is to govern the school.

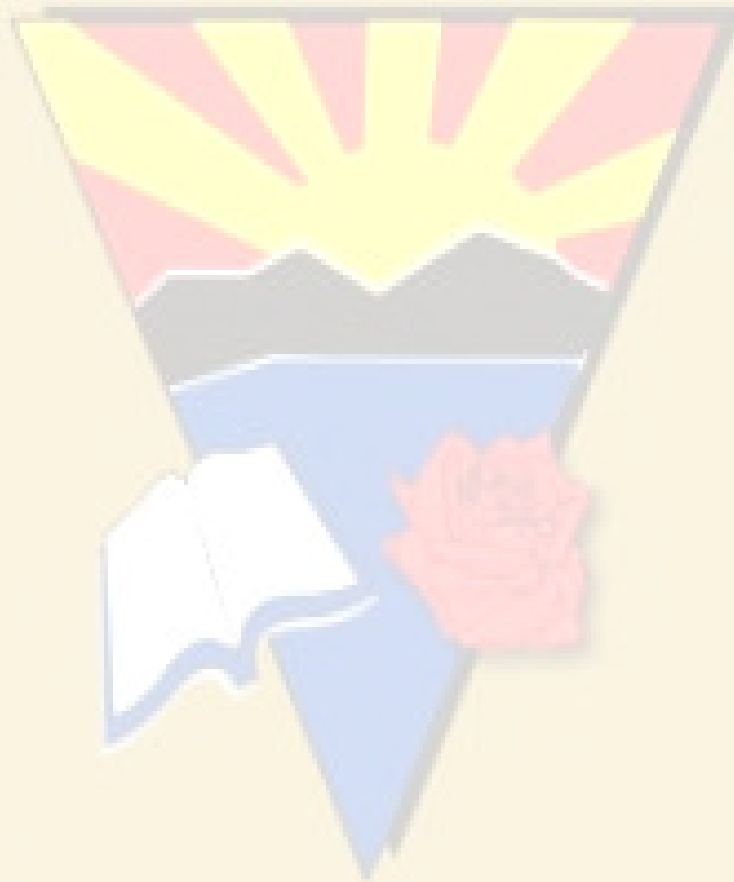
## 12.7 INVITATION
